Bishop Brooks is the Senior Pastor of Beulah Heights First Pentecostal Church in New Haven. In August 2018, Bishop Brooks was elected to the office of Presiding Bishop of the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc., an international organization that is more than 100 years old. He is also president and chief executive officer of Beulah Land Development Corporation, founded to create and revitalize stressed communities via affordable housing, economic development, and job opportunities.

Bishop Brooks serves on Yale-New Haven Hospital's board of trustees and its medical committee, as well as the board of trustees at Albertus Magnus College and the community advisory board at Southern Connecticut State University. He recently completed a 7-year term as a board member of the Community Foundation for Greater New Haven, where he served as chair.

He holds B.A., M.A., and D.Min. degrees, as well as a Ph.D. in religious studies.
